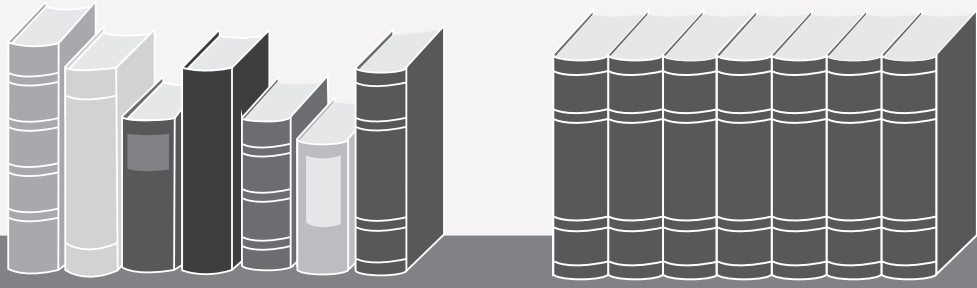

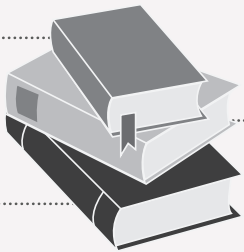
COLLECTIONS



The Kathryn A. Martin Library helps students and faculty connect to a world of knowledge through physical and digital collections. Physical collections are throughout the four floors of the library (and two floors in the Annex), and users have access to thousands of online resources and over 300 databases. In addition users can request materials through Get It and Interlibrary Loan services.

Assistance at this stage can help students navigate the entire research process. UMD librarians partner with faculty in and outside of the classroom, and help students individually develop their research skills and evaluate information critically.

FACILITY

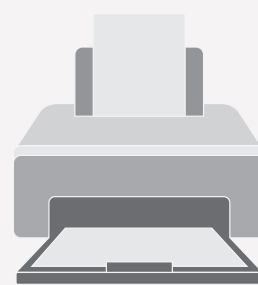


The library has four main floors (plus 2 floors in the Annex) of study rooms, research carrels, work tables, comfortable seating, and varying volume levels to meet the needs of our users. It is also home to the Securian Learning Commons which includes the Mathematics Learning Lab, Multimedia Hub, Tutoring Center, and Writer's Workshop. It is a facility with a space for every personality - the quiet and studious, the conversationalist, the solitary researcher, or the team.

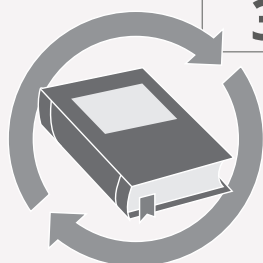
The library is well used and well loved, as one student said:
